Basic Class Information

Academics

Students are expected to be clean, dressed, and in their seats by 8am each morning. Studies consist of various Bible lectures, Bible application, Driving instruction, Computer & Technology training, Money management, Outreach techniques, and more. Students are expected to attend all classes, listen to lectures, take notes, complete homework, & score good marks on exams.

Behavior & Discipline

Our school is a Bible school at its core. All actions & behavior must align with Biblical values. We do not tolerate the following behavior: drinking alcohol, smoking, pre-marital sex, foul language, stealing, lying, cheating, and more. Any actions deemed necessary of discipline will be dealt with accordingly. Discipline administered is depending on the non-acceptable behavior which can include, but is not limited to: verbal warning, deduction of marks, suspension from class, reporting to police, etc.

Welfare

CCI School of Ministry has onsite dorms. Each dorm room houses two students and contains two beds, lighting, and one bathing area. Onsite are shared toilets, a shared common area for gathering, and a place to charge ones phone. Students are provided with two meals each day. A water source for drinking, washing clothes, & bathing is very near the dorms. A nurse is onsite two days a week to care for any medical needs.

School Fees & Provisions

Our fee each term is exactly 50,000 UGX. The total cost for the year is 150,000 UGX. These fees pay for the students food, the dorm room, water, personal computer for classroom use, one school shirt, one work shirt, and a Bible that is the student's to keep at the end of the school year. Fees must be paid in advance.

Schedule & Attendance

School begins each weekday morning (Monday-Friday) at 8am prompt. The morning begins with aloud Bible reading following with a short discussion. Monday & Wednesday of each week will continue with Bible lecture from Pastor Bill, Robb, & other teachers. Tuesday & Thursday of each week will consist of outreach training & application. Friday classes will alternate with Driving, Computers, Money Management, and other classes. Class schedule can change according to School of Ministry needs.

Students are to attend all classes unless given permission by Pastor Bill or Robb. Requests to be absent from one or more classes must be requested in writing in advance. There are no unexcused absences.
